

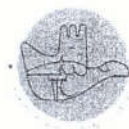

Celebrate Republic Day of India -2018



ACHIEVEMENTS :

- H.E. the Governor of Punjab and Administrator UT Chandigarh inaugurated 450 KWH solar plant on 20.12.2017
- Standing Finance Committee approved the project of Sports Injury Centre at a cost of Rs 36,23,82,000/- This will come up in the plot between GMCHAuditorium and Hanuman Mandir
- Standing Finance Committee has also approved 200 bedded New Emergency Block at a total cost of Rs 41.00 Crore.
- Detailed Project Report for development of 300 bedded Trauma Centre has been approved by Government of India. This is proposed to come up in sector 53 in about 9.5 acres of land.
- The detailed project report of 360 bedded Super-Speciality Block (Block-F) has been submitted to Chandigarh Administration for approval.
- GMCH has installed one more Oxygen Tank of 12,043 litres capacity
- Overflow Ward (OFW)- Area 53, with capacity to accommodate 50-60 patients has been started on 5th floor, Block-A to decongest Medicine Emergency. The stable patients who need observation are shifted to OFW from Medicine Emergency
- Government e-marketing (GeM) has been successfully implemented in the hospital for the purchase of various items. This has made the purchase easier and faster
- The approval for increase in number of MBBS seats from 100 to 150 and PG seats from 119 to 137 has been sent to MCI through Government of India.
- The civil work for a designated Swine Flu Ward i.e. B-5101 is under progress
- Patients' need identification and facilitation service have been started to solve the problems related to any service of the hospital being faced by patients/relatives
- Supply order of important equipments to improve patients' care like Portable USG machine with Color Doppler, 10 nos. Hemodialysis Chairs, Basic Endovision System for Endourology, 03 nos. OT tables hemodialysis machines (SLED) etc. have been issued
- GMCH has finalized SOPs for important procedures including disposal of Biomedical Waste, Sexual Assault Victims and Disaster Management
- Dedicated Dietetics OPD has been started in Medicine OPD.
- Lounge has been set up in Level-II, Block-C along with mobile canteen.
- In order to improve the care of cancer patients, a committee has been constituted for starting a division of Medical Oncology
- All the staff nurses of GMCH have been given sensitization for skill development for Basic Life Support

VISIONS:

- Engagement of staff, patients and civil society through regular dialogue for future growth of GMCH
- Education and empowerment of all categories of employee in order to make them equal partners in the delivery of quality care and training.
- To build a culture where every patient irrespective his status and socio-economic background is treated with compassion, dignity and respect.
