(B) DETAIL of VEHICLES / TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR THE AUCTION OF 03 NO(S) OF CONDEMNED GOVT VEHICLES OF THE CHANDIGARH ADMINISTRATION

1. The details of the condemned Govt. Vehicles to be auctioned by the Home Department, Chandigarh Administration is as under :-

2. Bidders will have to deposit the EMD in respect of condemned Govt. Vehicles in the shape of Demand Draft/Pay order in favour of Finance and Planning Officer, Chandigarh Administration payable at Chandigarh at 10.00 A.M. on the day of auction for being eligible to participate in the auction, failing which the Bidder will not be allowed to participate in the auction process.
3. The successful bidder will have to deposit 25% of the total successful bid amount on the spot and the balance amount i.e. 75% will have to be deposit within 72 hours from the date of auction otherwise the Earnest Money deposited shall be forfeited and watch and ward charges/penalties (if any) as applicable will be charged extra, before delivery of auctioned vehicles.
4. The Watch and Ward Charges will be Rs. 500/- per day per vehicle and the penalty will be levied equal to the same amount per day;
5. In case any bidder does not buy any vehicle during the auction process, his / her EMD will be returned on the same day after the auction process is over;
6. The successful bidder have to remove the vehicles at his own cost within three days of final payment falling which resale of the vehicle will be undertaken at the risk and cost of the defaulter and the earnest money deposit / bid amount paid for participation in the auction process shall be forfeited;
7. The successful bidder will have to pay Govt. Taxes/duties levies extra as applicable on actual basis on the vehicle purchased by him/her. The bidders are further informed that the vehicles will be allowed to be lifted only **“AS IS**

WHERE IS BASIS” after completing all the Govt. formalities, production of documents regarding deposit of taxes/duties with the concerned authorities. There will be no guarantee for its worthiness or quality by the concerned Departments.

8. The bidder will have to produce/submit his/her Identity proof and Pan card before the start of auction process.
9. The Auction Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any bid without assigning any reasons.
10. All the terms and conditions related to auction will also be announced before the start of auction on the spot;
11. The Earnest Money to the successful bidder will be released only after the deposit of sale proceeds and other relevant documents as required such as taxes / duties etc., if leviable. Earnest Money will be forfeited if he / she fails to honour the bid.
12. The delivery of the sold vehicles will be arranged only after the successful bidder submits documentary evidence in support of residential status viz. Ration Card/Voter Identity Card/Passport/Aadhar Card in case of individual and Registration Certificate in case of firm etc.
13. The successful bidder will also be responsible for getting the Registration Certificate of the vehicle transferred in his/her name at his/her own cost expeditiously. The Department will not be responsible for any lapse on his part in this regard.
14. The bidders will not be allowed to withdraw their bids failing which their Earnest Money will be forfeited.
15. In case of any dispute, the decision of Secretary Establishment, Chandigarh Administration will be the final.
