Chandigarh, December 17:- Following the instructions of the Punjab Governor and Administrator of UT, Chandigarh General (Retd.) S.F. Rodrigues to prepare the concept paper of Beant Singh Memorial within 15 days, UT Home Secretary, Mr. Ram Niwas today convened a meeting with Director Government Museum and Art Gallery, Mr. NPS Randhawa, Chief Architect, Ms. Sumit Kaur, Chief Engineer, Mr. Surinder Pall and Consultant, Ms. Namita Jaspal.

It was decided in the meeting to set up a Panorama depicting the martyrs' gallery with scientific explanations. Exhibits showcasing Jaliawala Baag, Lala Lajpat Rai, Udham Singh, Bhagat Singh, Guru Tegh Bahadur, Guru Gobing Singh and his children and in the end Beant Singh will be put up in the Martyrs Gallery. The Panorama will prove a major attraction for the people visiting Beant Singh Memorial. It was also deliberated to house photos of Beant Singh and his family, books which Beant Singh used to read, literature describing his life, achievements and contribution in a section dedicated to the Beant Singh titled 'Beant Singh Corner'.

During the meeting, Mr. Niwas asked Director Museum to install CCTV cameras in order to tighten the security of the Memorial. Chief Architect was asked to provide designs for the Conference Room within 15 days. Horticulture Department was also asked to undertake eco-beautification plan by planting mixed type of saplings in the Beant Singh Memorial Campus. A committee was constituted to buy books for the library, which include Special Secretary Finance, Director Government Museum and F& PO as members
