Punjab Liquor Licence Rules Amended

Chandigarh, Feb 2: The Chandigarh Administration has amended the Punjab Liquor Licence Rules, 1956. The rule will now be called the Punjab Liquor Licence (Chandigarh Amendment) Rules, 2010. This rule will come into force with the immediate effect.

In the Punjab Liquor Licence Rules, 1956, in rule 37, for condition 4 (b), the following condition will be substituted, namely:-

“ 4 (b) The grant of all new licences for the financial year 2009-10 onwards and their subsequent renewal will be granted subject to the condition that the applicant/ licensee will have to submit a No Objection Certificated from the owner of the premises (in case of leased premises), and the grant/renewal shall be subject to the validity of their rent/lease deed etc., provided that the condition will not be applicable on renewal of existing licenses issued prior to the financial year 2009-10 and grant of new bar licenses (L-3, L-4, L-5, L-10A & L-10AA) in a restaurant/ hotel.”
