**Chandigarh, March 15:- The Punjab Governor and Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh, Mr. Shivraj V. Patil, today held his Public Hearing Session at UT Secretariat. As many as 28 grievances were brought to his hearing including allotment of house & booth, job on compassionate ground, re-employment of NTT teachers and complaint against staff of Co-operation. The Administrator gave a patient hearing to the various delegations and individuals who came to put up their grievances and finding solutions to their problems. Most of the problems were sorted out on the spot and in respect of requests which needed examination, the senior officers were directed to initiate immediate action to give relief & justice to the applicants in a time bound manner as prescribed under the law.**

**Mr. Patil pointed out that most of the grievances brought into his hearing session relate to allotment of house, booths etc. or bereaved family members urging for job on compassionate ground. He directed the senior officials to sort out the routine issues at their level to the extent possible. He advocated the need of having a sympathetic approach towards the complainants.**

**Responding to the demand of an individual regarding the refund of the deposit money by the Chandigarh Housing Board, Mr. Patil said that the beneficiaries of any project of the CHB should not suffer due to any internal differences between the CHB and its partners.**

**On the matter relating to the Chandigarh Safai Karamchari Union, Administrator directed the Commissioner Municipal Corporation to examine the matter thoroughly within parameters of law. Mr. Patil taking serious note of a senior citizen grievance of being harassed by his son and causing mental torture, asked the IG Police to take necessary action and ensure justice to him.**
