Mantri Awas Yojna –“Housing for All” (Urban)

Chandigarh 8th December, 2017: The Chandigarh Housing Board has conducted the demand survey under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojna –“Housing for All” (Urban) for the EWS, LIG, MIG-I & MIG-II Categories, living in urban areas of Chandigarh.

Under the demand survey, 1,27,997 applications were received under various verticals of PMAY. Chandigarh Housing Board has tied up with various Banks for the Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme (CLSS) vertical under PMAY. 80548 applications (including 24999 applications verified by Estate Office) were received under Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme (CLSS) vertical of PMAY and have been sent to various Banks. The lists of such applications and Banks have been up-loaded on the web site of CHB (chbonline.in). The CLSS applicants can approach the concerned banks to avail the subsidy under the CLSS vertical subject to fulfilling eligibility criteria as per guidelines of PMAY Scheme.
